3. Sign your name and write today's date. You can even take the extra step and get your signature notarized. There is plenty of space on the bottom of the form to put a notary's stamp.
4. Post this pledge where you can see it every day. This will remind you of the pledge you made.
5. Create a plan of what you will do today, this week, this month, and this year to help reduce your home energy consumption and to create a clean energy planet.
6. Put your plan into action.
7. Get out in nature more often. Fall in love with nature. Reconnect with nature. We tend to protect that which we love and feel connected with.
8. Before you go to sleep tonight, do one thing to help create a clean energy planet.
9. Tell others about this pledge.
